3. DEVICE DISCOVERY

The EDS3000PR must have a unique IP address on your network. This IP address can be assigned automatically with DHCP, or you can assign it manually. The EDS3000PR looks for a DHCP server when it first powers up to assign an IP address. You can use Lantronix Provisioning Manager to locate the automatical- 5. Locate your device in the device list and note the ly assigned IP address.

1. Download the latest version of Lantronix Provisioning Manager from https:// www.lantronix.com/products/lantronixprovisioning-manager/.

- 2. Install Lantronix Provisioning Manager.
- 3. Run Lantronix Provisioning Manager.
- 4. If this is your first time running Lantronix Provisioning Manager, proceed through the initial setup.

4. IP ADDRESS CONFIGURATION

If the EDS3000PR was not assigned an IP address automatically through DHCP, you must assign one via CLI. If it was successfully assigned an IP address through DHCP, you can change the configuration via the Web Manager or CLI. The device's factory default 3. Change network settings, if needed, in Network > username is "admin" and factory default password is the last 8 characters of the Device ID. To configure via Web Manager:

- 1. Enter the device IP address in the address bar of a browser.
- 2. Log in to the EDS3000PR.
- Wired Network > Interface > Configuration, or perform other configuration.

To configure via Command Line:

- 1. Connect via a terminal emulator over serial or via Telnet (if the EDS3000PR already has an IP address).
- 2. Log in to the EDS3000PR.
- 3. Change network settings, if needed, in enable > config > if 1, or perform other configuration.
