






2. HARDWARE SETUP

- 1. Unbox and verify the contents. Gather the accessories that you will need.
- 2. Verify that the Lantronix Connectivity Services SIM is installed in SIM1 slot. The APN can be configured during Quick Setup
- 3. Attach the cellular / GNSS antennas to the antenna connectors and tighten them securely.
- 4. Optional: To enable Last Gasp, slide the battery switch to the left (ON). The battery is charged while the device is connected to an external power input.
- 5. Attach the Wi-Fi / Bluetooth antennas to the antenna connectors and tighten them securely. If you're using only Bluetooth, attach one antenna to the Wi-Fi / Bluetooth connector.
- 6. If using non-PoE power supply, attach the regional adapter to the power supply unit. Connect the 3-pin plug on the power cord to the DC input and the AC plug on the power supply to a standard AC receptacle. If using PoE power supply, it should be installed by a skilled technician according to the manufacturer's instructions.

3. LOG INTO THE ROUTER

Note: The DHCP client must be enabled on your computer to obtain a valid IP address from the router. Refer to your computer's operating system documentation if you need details.

To connect using Wi-Fi: In the computer's Wi-Fi network settings, select the router's Wi-Fi access point SSID and click Connect. Enter the default WPA/WPA2 key when prompted.

To connect using Ethernet: Attach one end of a Cat5 cable to the unit's LAN port and the other end to the computer's LAN port.

- 1. To access the Web Admin interface, open a web browser and type the unit's LAN IP address, 192.168.1.1, in the URL field.
- 2. Login as root using the default password. Change the root and admin user passwords and click **Save.**
- 3. Login as admin to begin configuring the device.



4. QUICK SETUP

To configure the network interfaces:

- 1. Log into the Web Admin, and click Quick Setup.
- On the Network Setup page, you can configure the LAN, WAN, Cellular and Wireless LAN (access point) network interfaces.
- The Lantronix SIM APN is data641003. To verify the configured SIM APN, go to Cellular > General Settings and view that Primary SIM is set to SIM1. Then click SIM1 settings and select Use Custom APN to view the APN.
- Click Save & Apply.

Note: Use the Lantronix Connectivity Services SIM Management Portal to manage the provided SIM card.
