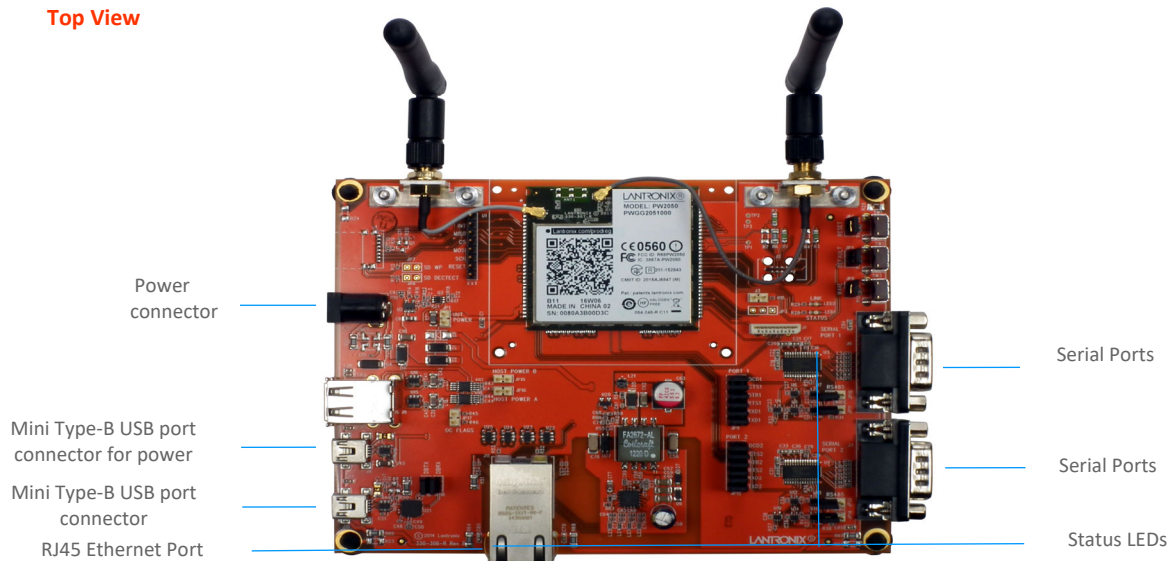

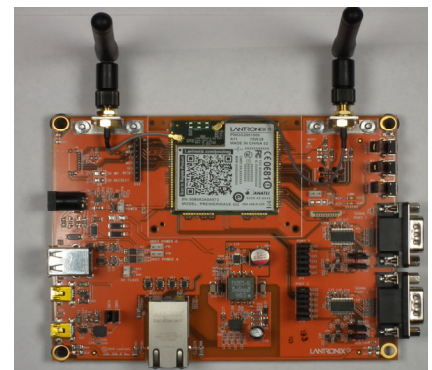

2. HARDWARE INSTALLATION—HOW TO ASSEMBLE

1. Attach the antenna(s) to the evaluation board.
2. Connect the unit to the network via the supplied Ethernet cable(RJ45) using the Ethernet port.
3. Supply power to the device by using the included power adapter.
4. Easily connect to the PremierWave 2050 via a mobile device or a computer with Wi-Fi capability as outlined below.

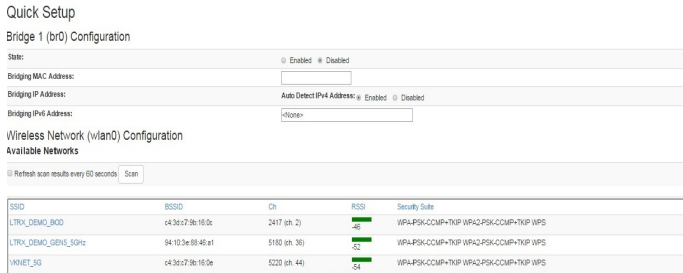
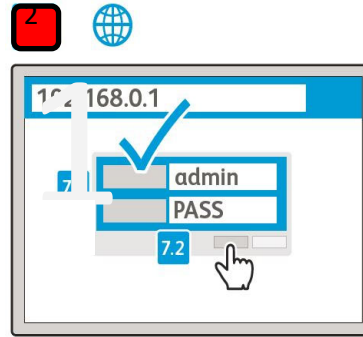
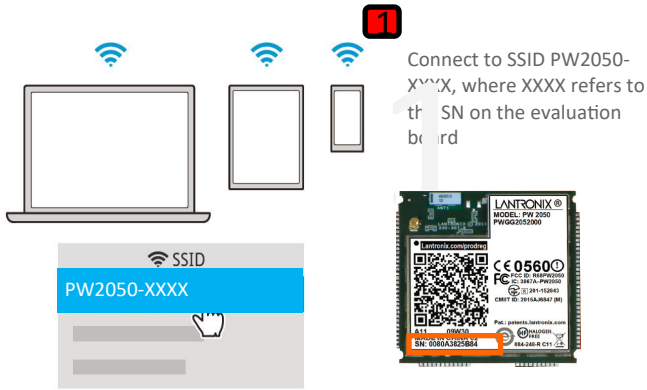




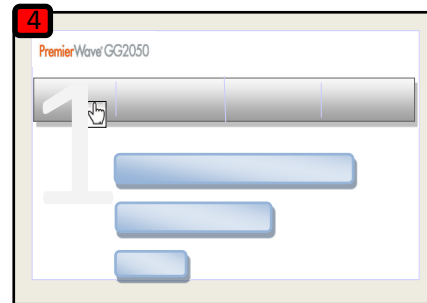

3. CONNECT TO WEB MANAGER

The steps below outline mechanism to access the web manager in order to configure the PremierWave 2050 device.



In the Quick Setup page, bridging and wireless interfaces can be configured. Bridging can be enabled and the Premierwave 2050 can be connected to a network from the list of available wireless networks.
