### **TN-EX-SFP-xx-xx & TN-JX-xx-xx Juniper compatible Small Form Factor Pluggable (SFP) Transceiver Modules**

Transition Networks TN-EX-SFP-xx-xx & TN-JX-xx-xx series small form factor pluggable (SFP) transceiver modules are designed to install any SFP port. These SFP modules allow a 100Base-FX, 100Base-LX and 1000Base-X interface to the network through the SFP connector. TN-EX-SFP transceivers are designed for bi-directional, serial optical data communications: Fast Ethernet, Gigabit Ethernet at speeds up to 1.25Gbps

## Installation

### **Installing the transceiver module**

To install the transceiver module, do the following:

1. Position the transceiver at the installation slot with the TN label side up (*standalone device*) or component side of slide-in card.
2. Carefully insert the transceiver fully into the slot.

### **Fiber cable physical characteristics**

The fiber cable physical characteristics must meet or exceed IEEE 802.3ae specifications:

Single mode fiber ( <i>recommended</i> ):	9 μm
Multimode fiber ( <i>recommended</i> ):	62.5/125 μm
Multimode fiber ( <i>optional</i> ):	100/140, 85/140, 50/125 μm

## Installation — continued

### Connecting fiber cables

To install the fiber cable, do the following:

1. Locate the appropriate fiber cable.
2. Install the cable as shown below.
